

**BY-LAW NO. 440/82**

A By-law of the Village of Bentley in the Province of Alberta to recover costs for damages to sidewalks, and/or curbs within the Village by transport trucks, backhoes, loaders, etc., or damage to sidewalks and/or curbs by other means.

THEREFORE Council sitting in regular session hereby enacts as follows:

THAT any person causing damage to sidewalks and/or curbs within the Village shall be required to pay for costs of repair to said sidewalk. Failure to pay for such repair within two (2) months time from date of billing by the Municipality, shall cause a fine of \$500 to be imposed, plus costs under the authority and pursuant to Section 110(1)a of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26, Revised Statutes of Alberta 1980.

READ a first time this 1 day of November 1982.

READ a second time this 1 day of November 1982.

READ a third time this 1 day of November 1982 and finally passed.
